

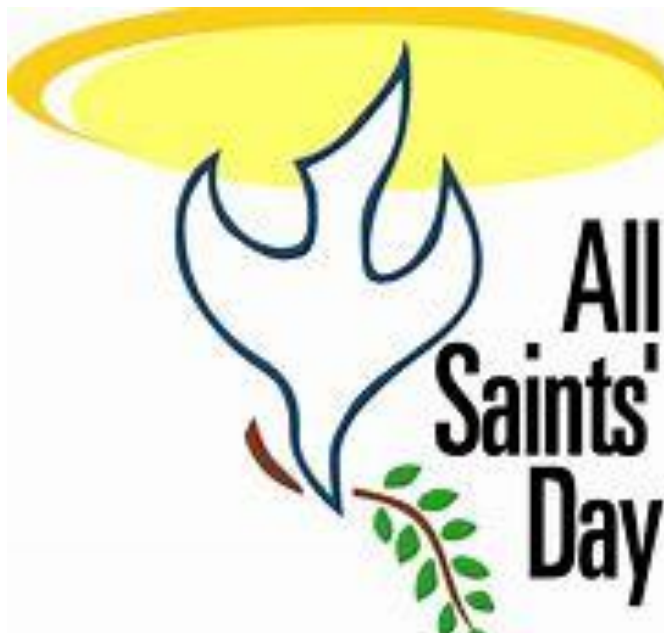
# St. Mark's Prayer Calendar for November 2018
