Dear Lord, as a new year begins, we come to ask your blessing. We pray that you would give us joy to fill our days and love to fill our hearts as we face the challenges ahead.

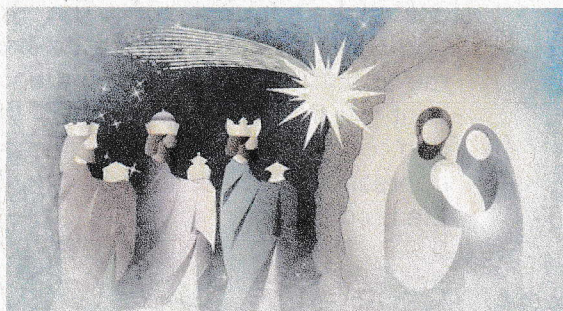
Fri 2
