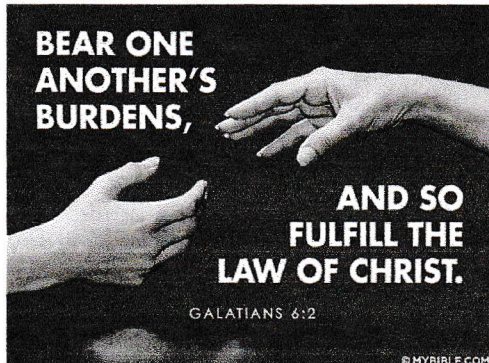
May we find time every day to really bless the Lord, as David expresses above and thank him for his great mercy towards us.
